There are two tracks for submission: (1) full paper (of a reasonable length), (2) extended abstract for poster presentation (maximum four pages). The pre-proceedings (edited in LaTeX) will be available during the conference.

Proceedings: a volume in Springer *Lecture Notes in Computer Science* series, for selected and additionally refereed papers, will be published after the conference; details will be given during the conference.
